The goal of the **Revisit Korea Program - Families** is to convey the deep gratitude of the Korean people to the relatives of all missing or unrecovered Soldiers, Sailors, Airmen, and Marines who fought in the Korean War in order to help ease their painful feelings of loss by allowing them to witness how Korea truly appreciates and enjoys the peace and prosperity that their noble sacrifices so dearly bought.



Eligibility:

- Must be designated next of kin, or companion thereof, of a serviceman listed on the Defense POW/MIA Accounting Agency website, <http://www.dpaa.mil>, who is yet unaccounted for. (Note: each serviceman, represented by the primary next of kin and a companion, will be honored just once. Additional relatives may be accommodated on that occasion only if space permits.)
- Must possess a valid passport which expires at least 6 months after expected entry into the Republic of Korea.
- A \$200 administration fee is required from all participants.

Benefits:

- 50% roundtrip airfare (economy; domestic & international) for primary family member and 30% roundtrip airfare for one accompanying person.
- Six days and five nights accommodations (room and all meals) for primary relative and first companion. Additional companions will receive reduced hotel and meal rates.
- All participants will be provided at no charge airport-hotel transfers by chartered coach on the designated travel days, all tour transportation, lunches away from the hotel, entry into all cultural events, and banquet seating.
